As the UK's most successful ever community crowd-funded project, with over 2,600 founding members contributing some £2.6 million to the distillery project, including many hundreds of investors from Edinburgh, the GlenWyvis Distillery will be a new landmark for the Highlands of Scotland and for community ownership.

Announcing the launch, GlenWyvis founder and managing director, John F Mckenzie, said:

"We are excited to release this special edition **GlenWyvis** gin for St Andrew's Day in Edinburgh, as part of our marketing push to raise awareness of our brand and build our audience engagement whilst the distillery is still under construction.

A community approach is at the heart of all we do – and this limited edition gin is designed to bring hyper-local appeal to gin aficionados in the Edinburgh to trigger further interest in our project in the Highlands.

It is the combined efforts of all the investors, not least those from the capital itself, that have helped us to create three full-time jobs to date with other part-time positions created in the run up to Christmas. In due course, we hope to extend the appeal of **GlenWyvis** to encourage members and visitors to visit the Highlands and the distillery in Dingwall as part of an overall whisky tourism experience."



GLENWYVIS LEASE FINALISED AS PLANNING PERMISSIONS PROGRESS

Thanks to the massive backing of investors, and the incredible support afforded to the project by so many, we have been able to make great progress with the long term aims of the GlenWyvis project and our aspirations to bring whisky distilling back to Dingwall.

This month our chairman, David O'Connor, and GlenWyvis founder and managing director, John F McKenzie, who is also the landowner, signed a 179 year lease for the distillery project. The lease now covers not one, but four sites on the farm, and the land has been secured for just £1! The lease will shortly be available to view on our website.

The four sites covered by the lease include the distillery site plus additional sites for two bonded warehouse sites, which all have full planning permission, and also an old house site which we are in detailed talks to secure planning permission for. This final site is highly important as it is intended for the Master Distiller's house. The position of Master Distiller will be advertised shortly – and we will keep all members informed of progress.
