GlenWyvis Distillery Customers and Members Data Protection Policy

1. GENERAL

- a. This Privacy Policy ("**Privacy Policy**") is provided by GlenWyvis Distillery Limited. based at GlenWyvis Distillery, 1 Upper Dochcarty, Dingwall, IV15 9UF.
- b. This Privacy Policy describes how and when we collect your personal information, what that information may be used for, who uses it, when it may be disclosed to other parties, how you can access your details and seek correction of your details, the control your own personal information and how you can contact us.
- c. By visiting the GlenWyvis website (<u>www.glenwyvis.com</u>) ("**Website**"), you are deemed to have read, and agree to be bound by, this Privacy Policy.

2. NOTICE

This Privacy Policy serves as a notice pursuant to The General Data Protection Regulation 2016 which replaces the EU Data Protection Directive of 1995 and supersedes the laws of individual Member States that were developed in compliance with the Data Protection Directive 95/46/EC. Its purpose is to protect the "rights and freedoms" of natural persons (i.e. living individuals) and to ensure that personal data is not processed without their knowledge, and, wherever possible, that it is processed with their consent.

 - 1. to affiliates, advisors, contractors, vendors or service providers for the purposes of operation and maintenance of our Website or our business, for

cross-promotional purposes and to otherwise provide customer support and services to you;

- to other third parties with whom we have commercial relationships, for marketing, advertising and related purposes, unless you have indicated that you do not wish for us to disclose to such third parties for marketing and advertising purposes;
- 3. social media websites; and
- 4. as required or authorised under law or provided in co-operation with any governmental authority.
- g. If you fail to provide us with Personal Information stated in paragraph 3(a) above, we may not be able to perform and/or carry out any of the Purposes.

Unless covered by any of the preceding points, your information will not be disclosed to any third parties without first receiving your prior consent.

4. MARKETING AND PROMOTIONAL COMMUNICATIONS

- a. We may use the Personal Information provided to send you information on products and services, and special or promotional offers, newsletters or customer survey forms and questionnaires unless you have indicated that you do not wish to receive such materials.
- b. You may **opt out** of receiving any communications from us at any time by contacting us with your request (see the CONTACTING US section below).

5. SECURITY OF YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

- a. We will take reasonable steps to protect any Personal Information we receive from you via our Website or other sources from misuse and loss and from unauthorised access, modification or disclosure. We may hold your information in either electronic or hard copy form or retain third parties to hold that information on our behalf. Where required by applicable laws, Personal Information will be destroyed or deidentified when no longer needed.
- b. By providing us with Personal Information or using our services or our Website, you consent to the transfer, storage and processing of Personal Information to our password-protected, cloud-based filing systems.
- c. However, as the Website is linked to the internet, and the internet is inherently insecure, we cannot provide any assurance regarding the security of transmission of information you communicate to us and you do so at your own risk.

10 BACKGROUND INFORMATION

- 1. WHY DO WE PROCESS YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?
 - a. Manage your membership of the GlenWyvis community benefit society or administer your order for goods or services – when you invest in the company or

make a purchase of one of our products, we will process your personal information, including your full name, postal and email address, contact information, payment and credit card information and other information that will be relevant in order for us to complete registering you for membership where appropriate and keeping proper records of your transactions with us.

- b. Provide our marketing and promotional items to you we may send you information and updates on our products, including the latest newsletters, promotions or deals, competitions, responses to your inquiries, updates on our website, or changes to our terms and conditions and policies.
- c. Enhance the provision of our services from time to time, we may perform market research in the form of surveys in order to obtain your thoughts on our products and services and how we can improve and further develop our services to serve our members and customers better. We may also conduct advertising campaigns and even promotional activities in relation to our products and services.
